June 3, 4, 5 th	Some folks will be arriving very early at the hotel on their own.
June 6, 2016	Transportation from Portland International Jetport provided for travelers by Best Western Van per flight schedules provided by attendees.***
June 7, 2016	Reunion begins tomorrow morning. Today many attendees will arrive in cars and transportation will be provided from Portland International Jetport. VIP Mercedes Sprinter and Best Western Van per flight schedules provided by attendees.***
Noon	Hospitality Room at Fisherman's Wharf opens.
5:30 PM-7 PM	Manager's cheese, crackers and wine reception at Fisherman's.
Evening	Dinner and evening on your own
8PM	Hospitality Room in Fisherman's Wharf Hotel opens.
Discussion	While the reunion does not start officially until June 8 th , the hospitality room will be open at noon at Fisherman's Wharf Hotel. Not only that the manager, Ramsey Lafayette, is providing a manager's cheese, crackers and wine reception this night.

Enjoy a free hot breakfast each morning you are at the hotel including the early arrivers. Unless otherwise noted you need to eat breakfast at the hotel you are staying at.

Those traveling by plane have received detailed information about keeping those picking them up at Portland's Jetport informed about any variations in their reported itinerary. Keep in mind when traveling that the airport is over an hour from the hotel so good communications is a must.

When the hospitality room is open someone will be needed to take responsibility for the room if memorabilia is left there on display. The hospitality room can stay open as long as someone is present to monitor it. When no one is available we will close it until the next scheduled opening. See Bob about that.

At various times during the reunion we will be treated to acoustic guitar, song writer and singer, Dave Hummel. Best of all Dave is a USS ORLECK sailor and this is his first reunion.

Discussion: The hospitality room will serve as the place to finalize our registration process. Most have registered and paid their registration fee in advance. For those who have not, this is the opportunity to do that. At this time you can also pay dues or make a contribution to the organization that could if you wish include the fund to help pay for shipmates to come to reunions that cannot afford to do so.

As has become a tradition we will serve free pizza during part of the registration process. In addition the hospitality room will be stocked with free snacks, bottled water and soft drinks for your use. Discussion: This is the day that breakfast will be at the Fisherman's Wharf Hotel and all attendees, no matter where staying, will eat at the Fisherman's Wharf. The purpose for this is to enable us to hold our business meeting. I want to make a request when we do this breakfast. The Fisherman's Wharf is a 54 room hotel and their breakfast bar was not built to handle a group as large as ours. So there might be delays as they try to keep the station supplied with food. Please be patient and kind to the staff as they try to serve you. That being said I would like to suggest that those whose last name begins with A through M try to come to breakfast before N through Z people. Let's try to have the first group come to breakfast at 6:45 AM and the second group at 7:00. That might help to keep the line from backing up.

WARNING: This document is subject to change. Do not bring it to the reunion and rely on the time, etc. of events for there could be changes. A final up-to-date version will be provided to you when you check into your hotel in Boothbay Harbor Maine.

** All items listed on this Plan-of-the-day are included in your registration fee. Your breakfasts lunches, and banquets are included as well as transportation during the reunion, entertainment, Memorial Service, entrance fees to area events, metal name badge, hospitality room and refreshments and more. All included. The reason for this note is so I won't have to write free next to each of the things above. :)

*** When you arrive at the airport you will proceed to the luggage claim area. You will be greeted by a representative of Layfayette Hotels (Tom Palmer or another) holding a sign or chalkboard with "USS ORLECK" or your name on it. He will see to it that you get to the vehicle that will transport you to your host hotel. It is critical that we know the airlines, flight and arrival date and time and are kept updated of any changes. For any changes happening before the day of your departure you must contact and talk to Bob Orleck about it. You should have his cell phone number with you (802-565-0340).

On the day you commence travel if there is any delay in your flight you will need to contact a different person. Tom Palmer is that person and you will need to give him an update. If you have to leave a message, do so but if you get a chance follow-up to talk to Tom in person to make sure he got the information. I cannot overstate how important that you do good communications with us since the hotels are over an hour from the airport. Failure to reach us with a change in your schedule could result in a very long wait at the airport for you.

Bad weather options: We expect great weather but there is always the possibility of rain. There may be situations that occur that could cause the cancellation or rescheduling of an event but be aware we have planned alternatives for that. Dress for the reunion is all casual. We will be on the ocean so you might wish to bring a jacket.

****In order to prepare for our Friday night banquet the hotel staff must have the area of our hospitality room and the restaurant to themselves to prepare for us. So when we arrive back from the Botanical Gardens and the Boat Trip in the afternoon, your free time will need to be spent either napping or around the many local places near hotels.
