Volunteer?

• Most things are done by arrival but there is always a need for help to do things like last minute paperwork, help in the hospitality room at the registration table, maybe run an errand, be a bus monitor, be willing to man the hospitality room at some points so it can be kept open and things kept secure, to help in serving the pizza, to assist with the silent auction or raffle things we do and a few other things as they arise. There is no requirement for you to volunteer or to feel guilty that you do not. There will be many who will and usually those are people who really want to do it.

Raffle or Auction:

- We spend more on each person than the registration they pay. To supplement that we use funds raised by our auction and raffle and contributions. One thing we auction is the "monkey fist" that was received by Tony Norris when USS ORLECK came home in 2000. Tony also threw the lines off when she left for Turkey in 1982. When I negotiate things I also get comps such as a free room for every 25 rented. I then turn those into money for our association and reduce the costs each must pay.
- If you want to help with this area, please bring something for the auction or raffle. Please do not make it too large for half of our people fly and that is becoming more difficult with the limitations put on luggage by airlines. There will be people who drive so those folks might bid on the larger items but it would be best if things are reasonably sized.

Weather and clothing considerations:

- The end of April in Virginia is beautiful. It should be nice and warm during this time but there will be the possibility of cool evenings, maybe some rain showers and we will be on a boat part of the time and in addition you will want to walk to beautiful beach our hotel is situated on. It will be nice though so don't think overpack with cool weather clothing.
- The dress code is casual. There will be no formal events. If anyone wants to dress up a bit the opening night at the hotel would be the most suitable for that but not expected. Some of us men wear sports coats and some of the women dresses but again that is not expected.
- I have worked to keep the walking to a minimum but when you do a stop at places and especially when you self-tour the USS WISCONSIN, you will want to have comfortable shoes.
